### RECYCLING BASICS

#### WHAT IS RECYCLABLE...AND WHAT IS NOT?

#### BEVERAGE CONTAINERS

Empty and rinse all containers. Flatten cartons.

##### RECYCLABLE

- Cartons and boxes
- Plastic bottles and jugs
- Aluminium cans
- Glass beverage containers (e.g. beer bottles)
- Tetra packs (milk, soy and juice only)

##### NOT RECYCLABLE

- Broken glass beverage containers

#### BATTERIES

Clean and undamaged batteries. Sort batteries according to type.

##### RECYCLABLE

- Lead-acid batteries (e.g. automotive batteries)
- Rechargeable batteries (Ni-Cd, Ni-MH, Li-ion, PB)
- Non-rechargeable batteries (Alkaline)

##### NOT RECYCLABLE

- Damaged or broken batteries

#### BOXBOARD

Flatten boxes. Remove lids and liners.

##### RECYCLABLE

- Cereal and cracker boxes (remove liners)
- Egg cartons
- Frozen juice containers (tin lids removed)
- Paper bags
- Shoe boxes
- Paper towel/toilet paper rolls

##### NOT RECYCLABLE

- Boxboard soiled with anything such as motor oil, paint or food/grease

#### CARDBOARD

Flatten boxes and remove any packing material

##### RECYCLABLE

- Appliance boxes
- Moving boxes
- Pizza boxes

##### NOT RECYCLABLE

- Styrofoam, foam packing material, cardboard soiled with motor oil, water or grease

#### ELECTRONICS

Clean and undamaged. Remove electrical cords and monitor bases.

##### RECYCLABLE

- Computer monitors and towers
- Mice, keyboards and cables
- Desktop printers, scanners and fax machines
- Televisions
- Cellular phones

##### NOT RECYCLABLE

- Commercial use printers, scanners and fax machines, computer speakers, stereos, video cameras, telephones, appliances

#### GLASS

Empty and rinse all containers.

##### RECYCLABLE

- Brown, clear, green and blue glass bottles and jars

##### NOT RECYCLABLE

- Ceramics, cookware, drinking glasses, incandescent bulbs, mirrors, windows, windshields

## PAPER

Sort newspaper and flyers separately. Secure shredded paper in plastic bags.

### RECYCLABLE

Catalogues and magazines  
Mail and envelopes (plastic windows OK)  
Telephone books  
Newspaper and flyers (glossy OK)  
Office paper (e.g. construction paper, printed paper)

### NOT RECYCLABLE








Carbon paper, padded envelopes; photographs and photo paper, thermal fax paper

## PLASTICS & PLASTIC BAGS

Empty and rinse all containers. Secure loose plastic bags in a plastic grocery bag.

### RECYCLABLE

ONLY items labelled with the numbers 1-7 inside a triangle, such as:

-  Soda, water, mouthwash and mustard containers
-  Detergent bottles, flower pots, milk jugs, shampoo bottles, spray bottles, yogurt and margarine tubs
-  PVC pipe
-  Squeezable bottles (e.g. honey)
-  Medicine bottles
-  Bakery Trays
-  Large reusable water bottles, juice jugs

### Plastic bags:

All bread, dry cleaning, produce and grocery bags

### NOT RECYCLABLE

Disposable diapers, compact disks, credit cards, hangers, hoses, pools, shoes, tarps toys, utensils

## TIN & ALUMINIUM

Empty and rinse all containers. Remove lids and labels.

### RECYCLABLE

Tin, aluminium, and steel cans and lids;  
Food cans (e.g. tuna, soup, pet food)  
Aerosol cans (empty)  
Aluminum food containers, foil wrap, foil trays

### NOT RECYCLABLE

Containers soiled with anything such as food or grease
