

## PAPER BLUE BAG MATERIALS ACCEPTED

✓ Newspaper & flyers



✓ Mixed paper

Stationery, computer paper, file folders, envelopes, newsletters, labels, magazines, catalogues, phone books, construction paper

✓ Boxboard

Detergent boxes, paper towel rolls, paper egg cartons, cereal boxes, paper bags



### REMEMBER ...

- Include clean paper products only
- Shred papers containing personal information
- Place shredded paper in a paper bag, cereal box or other non-corrugated box inside your blue bag

## CONTAINERS BLUE BAG MATERIALS ACCEPTED

✓ Rigid plastic containers

Plastic milk jugs, shampoo/liquid soap bottles, cleaning product containers, pill/vitamin bottles, clean plant pots, yogurt and margarine containers

✓ Rigid plastic packaging

from consumer goods, food, empty CD/DVD/VHS cases



✓ Plastic bags & film



✓ Beverage containers

Drink/milk cartons and boxes, plastic bottles, aluminum cans, tetra paks



✓ Plastic and metal lids



✓ Tin cans



✓ Aluminum foil wrap & trays

### REMEMBER ...

- Clean containers and plastic packaging only
- Place materials loosely in blue bag. No sorting required
- Take lids off containers. Place them in your blue bag
- Flatten plastic and metal containers, if possible
- No Styrofoam

## CARDBOARD & GLASS MATERIALS ACCEPTED

✓ Corrugated cardboard



✓ Pizza boxes

Remove and discard food residue, liners and inserts



✓ Glass containers

All colours of glass bottles and jars - food and beverage containers, beer bottles, wine bottles, pickle jars, canning jars



### REMEMBER ...

- Flatten and bundle cardboard with string, twine or tape
- Maximum bundle size: 36" × 24" × 12"
- Place glass containers in a reusable box
- Clean and remove lids from glass jars
